Trust4All project is the last in a sequence of consecutive projects that have delivered a solid, flexible and trustworthy architecture for embedded systems in several domains. The results have already been successfully exploited in several new product concepts and services. A major recognition of the successful outcome of this project was its key contribution to eight parts of ISO/IEC 23004 (M3W), which will be published as an international standard at the end of 2008. This standard will be considered for application in ITU IPTV and MPEG MXM.
